FACIS	DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Definitions

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include banks and other financial institutions, public benefit fund administrator, electric utility companies.	
Joint marketing Other Important Information	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include banks and other financial institutions, public benefit fund administrator, electric utility companies.	

Other Important Information

As a state agency, the Hawaii Green Infrastructure Authority is subject to chapter 92F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, which limits disclosure of certain records but also requires disclosure of certain records, including the name, address and occupation of any person borrowing funds from a state or county loan program, and the amount, purpose, and current status of the loan. However, to the extent that such state law requirements are inconsistent with federal law, the federal law requirements will apply.
