SAVE ON YOUR ENERGY BILL: PROGRAMS FOR HAWAI'I HOUSEHOLDS

HAWAI'I GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY GEM\$ PROGRAM

On-bill financing for energy improvements including Solar PV System, Solar Thermal Water Heater, Solar PV Water Heater, Heat Pump Water Heater, and Energy Storage Systems.



HECO BYOD PLUS

Offers customers incentives for purchasing a new battery and a customer-selected two-hour window everyday throughout the program participation duration. The battery will primarily serve the customer's household first and any remaining excess will be the target for BYOD Plus usage. The upfront incentive is \$400/kW committed and an additional \$400/kW for LMI households. The program also offers a monthly export credit.



FEDERAL WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (WAP)

WAP helps low- to moderate-income (LMI) residents reduce their energy bills by installing **free weatherization measures** (e.g., low-flow showerheads & faucet aerators, CFL or LED lighting, advanced power strips) in their homes. To be eligible, applicants must be within 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Guideline.



LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP/H-HEAP)

H-HEAP (formerly LIHEAP) provides federally funded assistance to reduce the costs associated with home energy bills, energy crises, weatherization, and minor energy-related home repairs.



HAWAII ENERGY SMART4HOMES

Installs **free energy efficiency upgrades** for eligible participants such as LED light bulbs, high-efficiency shower heads and aerators, and advanced power strips worth an estimated **\$150**. This is a no-cost program that can help residents **cut their annual energy bill by up to \$340**.
